

3/9/2022 Update

Since the start of the pandemic, AchievePoint has been committed to doing our very best to ensure the safety of students, staff and visitors. Effective immediately, AchievePoint is suspending its mask mandate policy. Students, staff and visitors will not be required to wear masks while in the school or at school events.

Students, staff and visitors exposed to COVID-19 must mask for 10 days after exposure.

Students, staff and visitors who test positive for COVID-19 must stay home for five (5) days and be symptom free before returning to school. After returning to school, students must mask for an additional five (5) days.

Students, staff and visitors who want to continue masking are encouraged to do so. AchievePoint is committed to ensuring that no one will be bullied or harassed for exercising their right to mask if they chose to do so.

AchievePoint will continue to provide masks (if desired) and plenty of sanitization products to ensure the safety of students, staff and visitors. The school will continue to be cleaned and sanitized at least once a day during the school week. AchievePoint expects all students, staff and visitors to ensure good hand hygiene in order to protect our community.
