



ACADEMIC GOALS

Our goal is to provide all students with the wrap around support they need to be successful in both high school and life after graduation. We believe in providing excellent academic support, relevant employability and soft-skill training and one-on-one social-emotional support.

We achieve these goals by:

- 1. Providing excellent academic support.** Teachers will increase reading and math performance in growth measured by Renaissance STAR. We will focus on individualized student plans based on Renaissance STAR assessment results, coupled with various innovative self-paced platforms we use on a daily basis. Our state-of-the-art and self-paced learning platform will provide students with the courses they need to graduate, and be prepared for state tests and life after graduation.
- 2. Providing relevant employability and soft-skill training.** We offer college and career-readiness support to each and every student by providing relevant courses, purposeful planned lessons around these topics, frequent guest speakers from varying professional backgrounds and training and support with our college and career-readiness computer-based platform.
- 3. Providing social and emotional support.** We offer students wrap-around support from their teacher, academic coaching, the executive director and principal. The AchievePoint team is available to students whenever possible to provide support and resources. We aim to increase each student's connectedness to the school and the value of their education. We use a platform to help assess where each student may need support in the areas of social and emotional well being and reference it often to help us help our students.
- 4. Post high school planning.** We work with students to develop a Student Success Plan (SSP) that organizes graduation requirements in a student-friendly manner that is consistently updated throughout the academic year. The purpose of the SSP is to work cohesively with students during their time at AchievePoint, and after they graduate, until they have established postsecondary plans.

Our philosophy is simple:

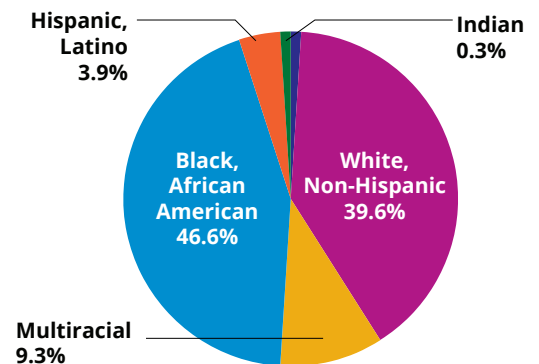
- We see a high school diploma as a milestone, not a destination.

SPONSORS' STATEMENT

St. Aloysius, as the sponsor of this school, is legally mandated to provide oversight, monitoring, and technical assistance. ACADEMIC MEASURE

- Achieve3000 used for reading growth tracking and progress
